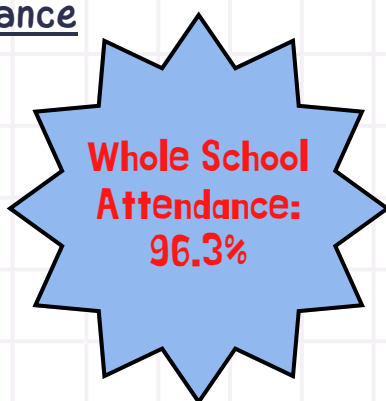
First Holy Communions
