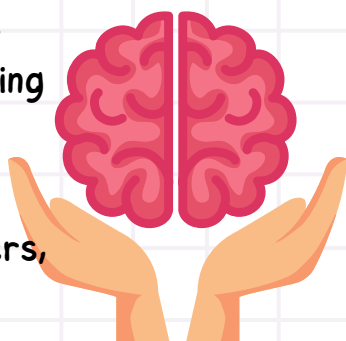
Dear Parents and Carers,

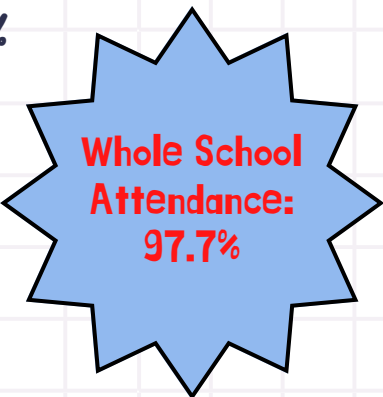
## Next Week is Walk to School Week!
