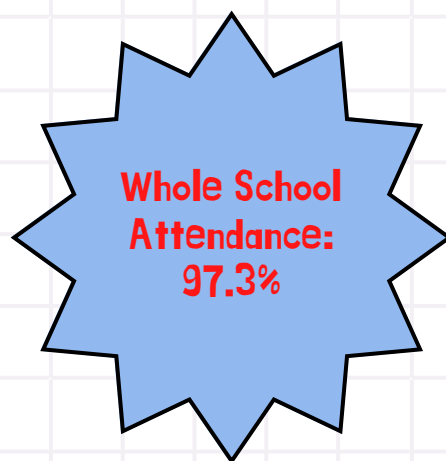
Parking around the school
