Dear Parents and Carers,

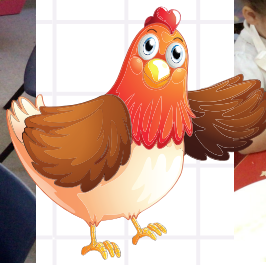

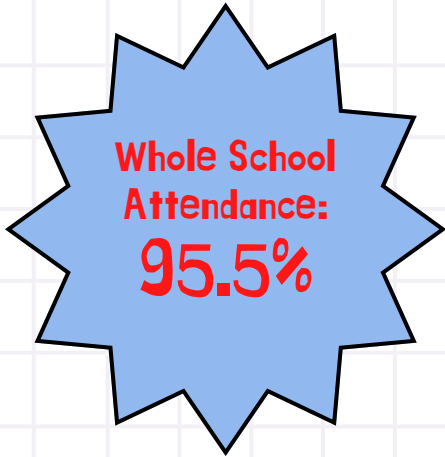
## Year 2 travel into London!
