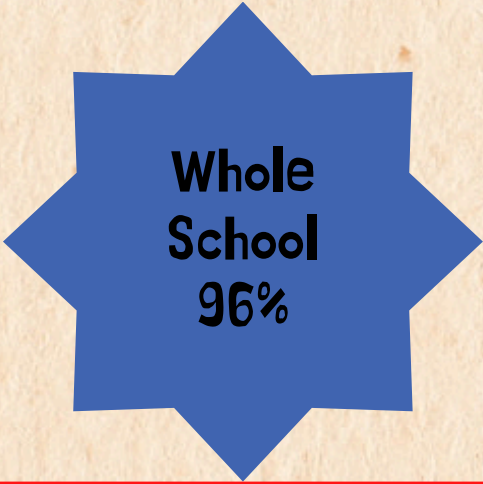
Class Pilgrimages
