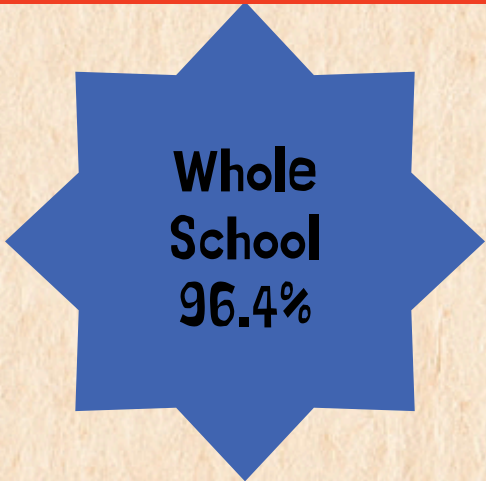
Celebrating Achievement
