

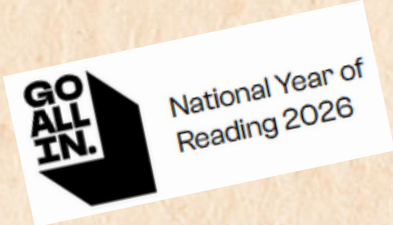
STM Weekly Round Up

Dear Parents and Carers,

This week’s assembly focused on the story of John the Baptist and his important role in bearing witness to the true identity of Jesus. Together we explored how John the Baptist prepared the way for Jesus and courageously spoke the truth about who Jesus was. We discussed how John’s actions remind us the importance of being honest and brave even when it is not easy and how important it is to make time to truly know each other. The children were encouraged to reflect on what it means to ‘bear witness’ in their everyday lives and how we must show kindness and compassion to others. Teachers have also spoke with children this week about how words and actions can reflect Jesus’ teachings, helping us to be positive role models and show kindness within our school community especially by showing the expected behaviours both inside and outside of the classroom and that any kind of rough play or rudeness towards children or staff is unacceptable. We would greatly appreciate your support in reinforcing these messages at home and we hope you take the opportunity to take a few moments to speak about this with your child. Thank you.

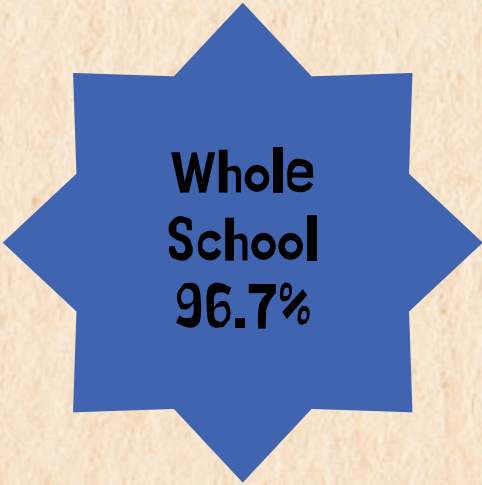
Cooking class bake cup cakes!
