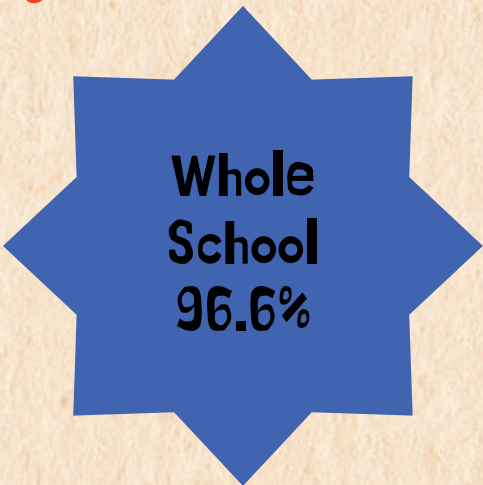


Election for Parent Governor
