### Extra Curricular Clubs

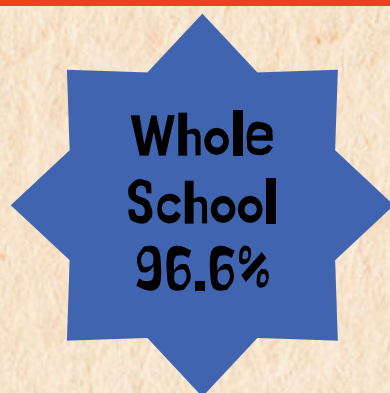
