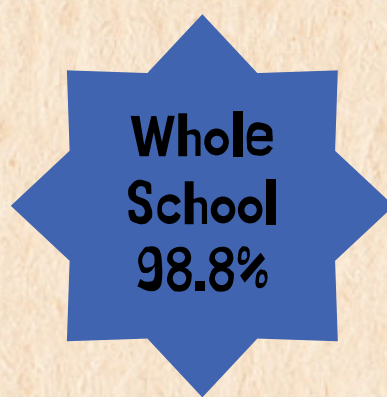


Changing Weather
